Membership fees include FAC, County (CAA), Regional (SCAS) and Archery GB affiliation fees.

Shooting fees: Quarterly (1st Sept/Dec/Mar/June) shooting fees (payable in advance by standing order, online banking, cash or cheque):

FAC are offering a discounted fee of £200.00 p.a. for senior members 65yrs+ paying 12 months in advance from 1st September.

FAC & Associate members Seniors - 65yrs+	-£52.00 per quarter
FAC & Associate members Seniors - 25 -64yrs	- £54.00 per quarter.
FAC & Associate members Seniors - 18-24yrs	- £27.00 per quarter.
Associate Juniors - under 18s	- £15.00 per quarter
FAC Juniors - under 18s	- £15 per quarter OR FREE if accompanied by a parent / guardian who is a full FAC member.
FAC Archers with disabilities – all categories	- fees to be on individual basis within Archery GB guidelines
FAC Coaches	- £40.50 per quarter

It is a condition of membership that all members must take part in the setting up and putting away of all equipment at shoots.
